

AMEJA Statement on the One Year Anniversary of A "Forgotten War"

Monday, April 15th, 2024 marks the one-year anniversary of the civil war in Sudan, a conflict that has led to the world's largest internal displacement crisis and has subjected Sudan's population to the catastrophic possibility of famine. More than <u>15,000 deaths</u> have been recorded and the effects of this war extend well beyond the country's borders.

While the wars in Gaza and Ukraine have garnered enormous media coverage, the conflict in Sudan has taken a backseat. Some experts are <u>calling it</u> the "forgotten war." AMEJA asks media organizations to increase coverage of one of the largest humanitarian crises in the world right now and end this deafening silence.
